


# Norton Internet Security 2013 (Updated and Default Settings)

### Caught Later By Behavioral Blocking, Firewall, Etc.:

- **Norton caught 3 of the 10 missed files, but not sure which one because my vmware froze and I had to shut down. Hitmanpro found 2 riskware and 2 Suspicious files. Malwarebytes found 8 potentially unwanted programs, 2 adware's, 1 hijack, and 1 Trojan.**

## Malware Pack Containing 667 Files (2 Day Old Files):

- **345/667 = 51.72% (Horribly Bad)**

### Summary:
