

Advantages and Disadvantages:

Advantages:

- Nice Interface
- Good detection rate for 0 day files
- Behavioral blocking seemed to work pretty good
- Good custom scan speeds

Disadvantages:

- Pretty high ram usage
- Web blocking was not the best!
- Updating takes awhile
- Every time I restart computer and I click Kaspersky icon to open it's interface, it says, "Loading the application." Even though the computer finished booting up, Kaspersky is still booting up. (I was just informed by one of the users of Kaspersky today the 23rd that you can "enable concede system resources option in KAV settings," to make it much faster. I am still going to leave it as a disadvantage because an average user would not know about that.)

Summary:

- According to my testings, Kaspersky did manage to do the hard work. I wish they did good on web blocking though to make it easier for me to recommend it, but I will still recommend it because its detection rate was high and the behavioral blocking seemed to work, so if you have a web link that goes through, then at least Kaspersky still has a chance.
